NEWSLETTER

UNFOUND processes personal data if you are part of our mission, or if you just love to hear from UNFOUND, or you provided it when you wanted to know more about our adventures. Following details are only used for the newsletter sent occasionally: Firstname and lastname, email address, title, and company. This data is saved via Mailchimp and they take data privacy very seriously, read all about this in their privacy policy.

GOOGLE ANALYTICS

UNFOUND uses Google Analytics to keep track of the behavior of the visitors of our website. The information thus obtained, including a part of the visitors IP address, is transferred to and stored by Google on servers. This information is only processed in a way that does not identify anyone. We do not make, and do not allow Google to make, any attempt to find out the identities of those visiting our website. COOKIE STATEMENT

Our website offers tiny bits of extra data, a.k.a. 'cookies'. With these 'cookies' the website asks your browser to remember some 'data'. If you allow your browser (settings) for 'cookies', then your browser will send those (same) 'data cookies' back, each time it visits the website. This happens as long as the cookies do not go past the expiry date. Some cookies disappear if the browser is closed, others stay fresh longer.

WHY WE USE COOKIES

This way the website is reminded that your browser is unique. With this uniqueness in cookies, memories of previous encounters can be stored and used. HOTJAR
